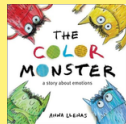

SUMMER

It has been another busy term and we wanted to share with you some of what has been happening in classes throughout school.

CLASS 1

This term, the children in Nursery enjoyed their first transition session meeting their new Reception teacher. They took part in exciting activities linked to their upcoming topic, All About Me. They listened carefully to the story, The Colour Monster, before exploring different activities; sorting pom-poms into the corresponding coloured pots, counting how many of each colour they had. In the fine motor area, the children created self-portraits and practised writing their names. Outside, they explored coloured water, mixing, measuring, and stirring with enthusiasm. The children had a fantastic morning, demonstrating excellent resilience, wonderful manners, curiosity, and confident exploration throughout all the activities.



CLASS 2

This half term, Class 2 had a fantastic trip to Boston Park Farm, and a great day was had by all! The children enjoyed a nature trail and trailer ride, where they explored the countryside and learned more about the natural world. They also developed their understanding of the parts of a plant and had the opportunity to plant their own vegetable seeds. During the visit, they met and fed a variety of farm animals, and the highlight of the day was seeing a baby alpaca that was only minutes old. It was a truly memorable experience for everyone!



CLASS 3

In Class 3 this term, the children visited the Old Rectory in Epworth for an exciting trip to learn about the life of John Wesley. The children enjoyed object handling activities where they explored items from the past and discovered their importance. They also made herbal medicines and learned how plants were used for health in the past. A special lesson from Susanna Wesley introduced them to Latin and showed how children learned during John Wesley's time. The trip was fun and educational, helping Class 3 understand history in a hands-on way.



CLASS 4

Class 4 have enjoyed a fantastic Summer Term filled with exciting opportunities and memorable experiences. Our Year 6 pupils proudly represented the school at the Brownlee Foundation Triathlon at Hymers College in Hull and also took part in the inspiring Church Schools Festival at Lincoln Cathedral. In Art, they have used clay to create beautifully decorated flowers, experimenting with colour and pattern. They have also made the most of the warm weather by enjoying outdoor learning in the cool shade of our Forest School. In Science, the children explored the circulatory system before applying our learning during a fun whole-school Joe Wicks workout session in the hall.
