Attendance & Punctuality at Risley

In such cases, for **safeguarding and health, and safety reasons**, please ensure that you **sign your child in** upon arrival.

Pupils in Year 3, 4, 5 & 6 can bring they can each bring a piece of fruit for playtime if they wish.

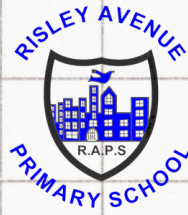
Please talk to them about sitting to eat it and disposing of any left overs in the litterbins provided.

School Uniform

Pupils should wear full school uniform, Risley Jumper, black/grey trousers or skirt (in Reception/Nursery jogging bottoms are best). Sensible black shoes or **ALL black** trainers should be worn. Class teachers will be monitoring the wearing of uniform and contacting parents where necessary. We are preparing the children for secondary school so getting into the habit of following the policy is very important. Thanking you in advance for your cooperation.

Pupils now also need to bring a PE kit of a white T-Shirt and blue/black shorts/leggings with all black trainers or plimsolls.





Contact Information

Please ensure that you promptly inform the school of any changes to your personal details, Such as your address or mobile phone number. It is essential that we have up-to-date contact information in the event of an emergency. For health and safety purposes, we also require the contact information of two additional individuals who can be reached if we are unable to contact you.



Parking

Please do not park on Bedwell or All Hallows Road in the morning as this is presenting a health and safety risk to pupils. If you have to drive, park on Flexmere Road or Church Lane where there is plenty of room. TFL and Haringey Parking Enforcement Officers will be regularly monitoring our area.

Play Equipment

We ask that the play equipment, climbing frames & the caged football areas are **NOT** used by pupils before and after school. If Parents let their children play on equipment, it is at their own risk.



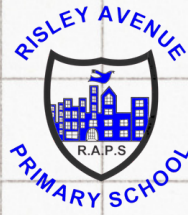
Raising Concerns & Acceptable Behaviour

If you have a concern, please refer it in the first instance to your child's class teacher. You could call or email the office to arrange a phone call or appointment. If the problem is not resolved, then you can make an appointment with a member of the senior leadership team. Senior staff are also on the gate in the morning and playground in the afternoon each day and can deal with any questions you may have. Staff at Risley make every effort to hear concerns straight away but please bear in mind that this is not always possible.

When airing your concern please do so in an appropriate manner. Verbal or physical abuse of staff will not be tolerated. I also remind you that Governors can take measures to restrict access to the school premises if necessary in order to safeguard staff and pupils.

Please **do not** approach pupils or other parents in the playground to try to sort out the problem yourself, always refer to a member of staff.





Valuables



We ask that valuable items are not brought into school e.g. mobile phones, computer games, stereos etc. If items must be brought in, pupils must hand them in to their class teacher. Risley cannot accept responsibility for loss of any such items.

If you cycle or ride to school, for health & safety reasons please can I ask that you and your child dismount whilst on the pavement outside the school or in our school playground. The bike sheds may be used to store items during the school day but we advise that locks are used. **Risley cannot accept responsibility for loss of any such items.**



Breakfast Club

There is a £1 daily charge for childcare of children attending Breakfast Club. If your child would like to have breakfast during their time in the club, this will be provided free of charge.

Breakfast Club operates from 7:45 AM to 8:45 AM. If your child arrives at school during these hours, **you will be charged.**

Please note that all payments should be made in advance, and can be processed via ParentPay or the card machine in the main office.

Healthy Packed Lunch & Party Bags

Risley is a healthy school and therefore we must promote healthy eating. If your child has packed lunch please could you ensure it contains healthy food. Chocolate bars, cakes, crisps, sweets and fizzy drinks are all unhealthy snacks and contain high quantities of sugar, salt and additives that can affect how your child concentrates at school.

The school cannot distribute birthday party bags due to food allergies.
