Dear Year 2 Parents and Carers,

As we come to the end of another successful school year, we would like to congratulate our Year 2 children on completing Key Stage 1. We are incredibly proud of everything they have achieved and look forward to welcoming them into Year 3 in September as they begin Key Stage 2.

To help prepare for this exciting transition, the children have recently been spending time in the Key Stage 2 playground, becoming familiar with their new surroundings and routines. From September, there will be a few changes to the school day arrangements.

Key Stage 2 Playground

Year 3 children will use the Key Stage 2 playground for drop-off, breaktimes, lunchtimes and collection.

There are two entrances to the playground. For drop off in the morning, Year 3 and Year 4 children use the gate next to the green AstroTurf, while Year 5 and Year 6 children use the other gate.

To help the children settle into their new routine:

- **Monday 7th and Tuesday 8th September** – Parents and carers are welcome to accompany their child into the Key Stage 2 playground. Class teachers will meet the children, who will line up with their class before going into school.
- **From Wednesday 9th September onwards** – Children should be dropped off at the KS2 gate by the Astro Turf, where senior members of staff will welcome them into school each morning.

End of the School Day

Parents and carers may enter the Key Stage 2 playground through either gate to collect their child. Year 3 children will be dismissed by their class teacher from behind the gazebo, on the far left-hand side of the playground. Please wait in this area for collection.

We appreciate your support in helping the children make a smooth transition into Key Stage 2 and are confident they will enjoy the opportunities that Year 3 brings.
