It has been a busy term and we wanted to share with you some of what has been happening in classes throughout school.

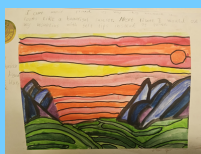
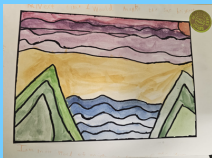
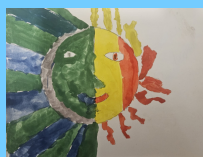
RECEPTION

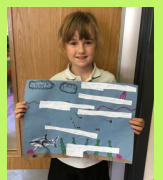
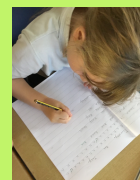
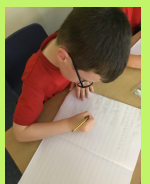
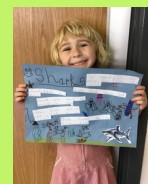
YEAR 2

YEAR 1

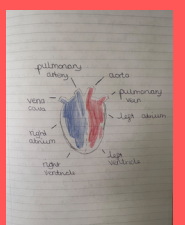
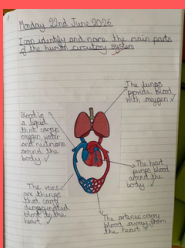
YEAR 5

Year 5 have thoroughly enjoyed their Science topic, focusing on plant reproduction. They dissected lilies identifying the different parts and learned how pollination and fertilisation leads to the formation of seeds and fruits. The children also explored the life cycle of flowering plants, investigated seed dispersal and germination, and compared different plant species. A particular highlight was propagating spider plantlets for the classroom, discovering how some plants can reproduce from a single parent. They all showed great curiosity, enthusiasm, well done, Year 5!



YEAR 6

This half term, Year 6 have shone in their science unit. They have learnt about the different parts of the heart and how they function. The children learnt how to check their own pulses which they thought was very strange! After that, they studied how to live a healthy lifestyle as well as the effects of certain products on the human body.
