I am writing to inform you of recent changes to the leadership of our Academy Monitoring Committee (AMC) which forms part of our schools' and trust's governance structure.

Sally Moorman and **Claire Noonan** stepped down as Co-Chairs of the AMC for the Trentside schools (Haxey, St. Martin's and West Butterwick CE Primary Academies) at the end of the last academic year owing to work and family commitments.
